

Wey Valley Academy Catch up Premium strategy- 2019-20.

Year 7 Catch up premium

Funding for students that have KS2 levels of below Level 4 (Scaled score 95 or below) at KS2 in Reading, Maths or both.

At Wey Valley Academy the barriers to raising attainment are:

1. Literacy skills entering Year 7 are below National Average and this will prevent students from accessing texts and the new GCSE specifications
2. Numeracy skills entering Year 7 are below National Average
3. Deprivation and low social mobility of local area
4. 'Some feeder schools have not ensured rapid and sustained progress over students' primary schooling'

As a result of this 3 targets have been set:

- 1. To raise the attainment and progress of Catch up premium students to bring outcomes which are in line with the cohort.**
- 2. To increase the attendance of Catch up premium students who are persistently absent.**
- 3. To ensure progress in maths Catch up premium students.**
