Year 11 Prom 2021 – Nothe Fort – 17:30 - 20:30

I am so pleased that we have been able to make a Prom possible for you this year – despite all the setbacks and uncertainty. Having been to the Nothe Fort to check out the facilities I know it is going to be a fantastic event – the location is amazing and I feel that things have worked out better than we could ever have hoped for. To ensure that everything runs smoothly I would like to now set out a few guidelines and ask that you follow some basic rules.

1. **Arrival Slots** - Because the road leading to Nothe Fort is narrow and it is a residential area, we can not have everyone arriving at the same time. 2. **Food** will be provided – burgers, ice cream and a drink. By using the link, please indicate if you would prefer a vegetarian or vegan option - <https://forms.office.com/r/cV304ux7Gc>.
3. **Cars and Parking** - as Mr Russell stated in his letter last week you will not be able to drive long or unusually large cars up to the Nothe Fort on Barrack Road, as it is a residential street, very narrow and has a hair pin bend. Therefore we advise you to either arrange to be dropped off in Hope Square, where you can then walk up to Nothe Fort, or arrange for a “normal” car to drop off in the turning area in front of the Fort.
4. **Spectators** - There is very limited parking at the Fort, so please ask parents and friends who want to watch, to park in one of the town car parks and walk up the short distance to the Fort.
5. **COVID** – to try and limit the risk of Covid spreading, please take a Lateral Flow Test on the day of the Prom and only attend if this shows a negative result.
6. **Masks** – please bring a mask to wear in any indoor spaces.
7. **Alcohol and illegal substances** – alcohol, cigarettes, vapes and any illegal substances will not be permitted. If anyone is suspected of using or having used these prior or at the Prom, they will not be admitted or will be immediately asked to leave.
8. **Tickets** - Please make sure all tickets are collected from Wey Valley Reception prior to the Prom. Bring the ticket with you on the night as this will be checked before you enter.
