# How do I GAIN points?

Actions that GAIN Prom points	Number of points
Achievement Points	1
Letter Home	3
Attendance at revision / intervention (per session)	1
Participation in extra-curricular activities	1
>98% attendance between 05 Jan 2022 and 24 May 2022	20
>95% attendance between 05 Jan 2022 and 24 May 2022	10
Zero exits or subject removals between 05 Jan 2022 and 24 May 2022	10
Zero lateness between 05 Jan 2022 and 24 May 2022	10

# How do I LOSE points?

Actions that LOSE Prom Points	Number of points
Poor behaviour: warning	-1
Poor behaviour: exit	-2
Poor behaviour: subject removal	-3
Poor behaviour: after-school detention	-4
Poor behaviour: internal exclusion	-5
Poor behaviour: fixed-term exclusion	-10
Punctuality: repeat lateness (Tutor / HOY / SLT decision)	-1
Uniform: repeat uniform problems (Tutor / HOY / SLT decision)	-1



What's in it  
for me?

- IF STUDENTS HAVE  $>98\%$  ATTENDANCE AND AT LEAST 50 POINTS THEN THE SCHOOL WILL PAY 50% OF THE PROM TICKET COST
